

# Proverbs 3:1-12 (NIV2011) page 934

<sup>1</sup>My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart <sup>2</sup> for they will prolong your life many years and bring you peace and prosperity.

<sup>3</sup> Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them round your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. <sup>4</sup> Then you will win favour and a good name in the sight of God and man.

<sup>5</sup> Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup> in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

<sup>7</sup> Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil. <sup>8</sup> This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

<sup>9</sup> Honour the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops;
<sup>10</sup> then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.
